KEY FACTS:

- The IFC is a Non-Lethal (NL), blunt trauma, bolt action weapon system
- Variable velocity weapon that rapidly fires on targets at different ranges
- Designed to replace current NL blunt impact munitions
- Reduces logistics and weight burdens associated with carrying multiple NL blunt impact systems

Capabilities/Characteristics:

- Weapon system providing NL engagement out to 100 meters
- Fires one projectile with different muzzle velocities as desired by the user
- Ability to rapidly fire at approaching threats
- More accurate at greater distances than other similar NL blunt trauma capabilities
- Replaces current suite of NL blunt impact weapon systems
