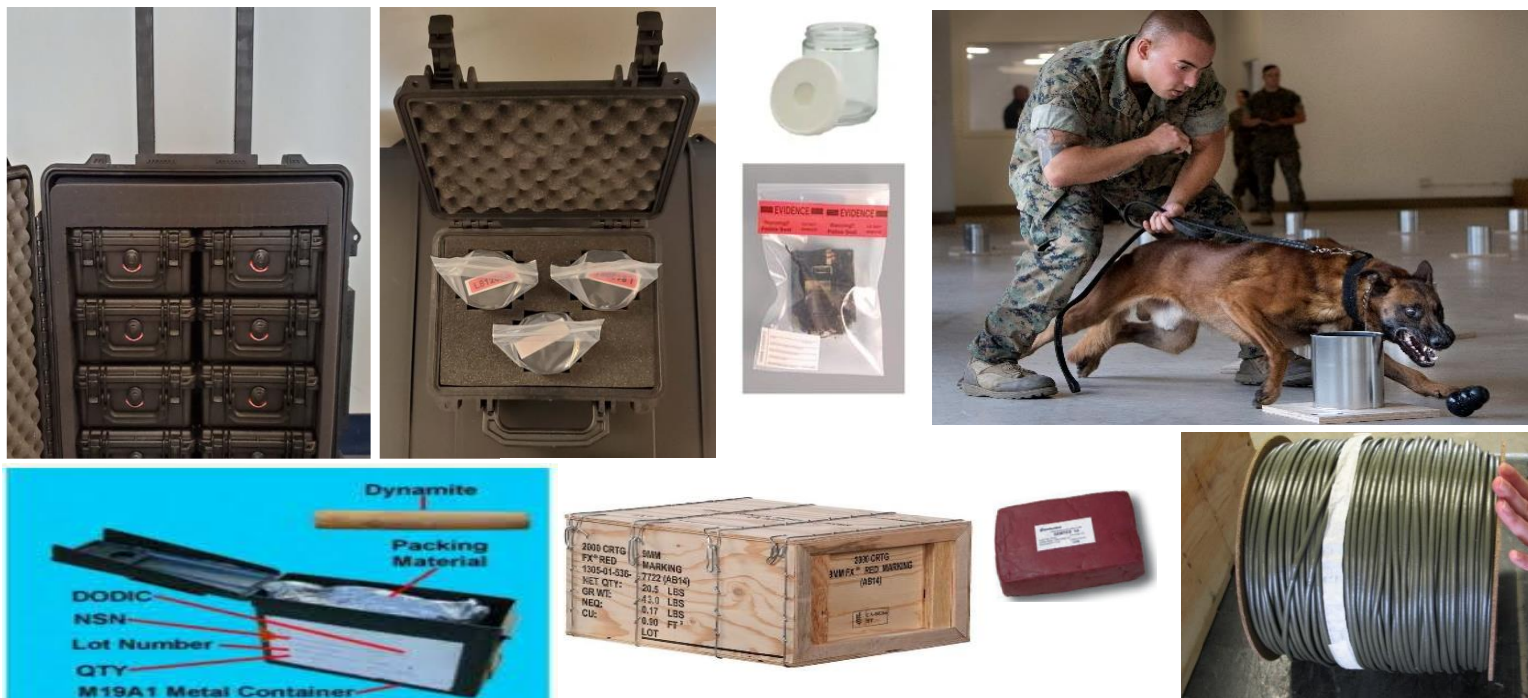


Canine Explosive Scent Kit (CESK)



ON EVERY MISSION

KEY FACTS:

- Each service uses a different CESK configuration.
- Each service equips their handlers for specific missions and training.
- PM-CCS procures individual scents for the US Army CESK.
- Working to unify diverse stakeholder support.
- The newer kits (Pelican Cases) will contain Training Aid Delivery Devices (TADDs) for the energetics.
- The TADDs will prevent cross contamination of odors.
- For the replenishment of energetics, the Pelican Cases WILL NOT be turned in, only the TADDs.
- The TADDs will be transported yearly within an M19A1 container.

Capabilities/Characteristics:

- Pelican Case 1150 will contain three (3 ea) 4oz TADDs containing identical explosive odors.
- There are eight (8 ea) Pelican Case 1150 in one (1 ea) Pelican Case iM2875 Class 1 Explosives.
- The CESK will be replaced annually. They will be transported within one (1 ea) M19A1 metal container.
- There will be three (3 ea) TADDs in one (1 ea) M19A1 metal container.
- A foam insert will separate the three (3 ea) TADDs within the M19A1 metal container.
